MATERIALS AND TOOLS

- Yarn #4 - medium yarn
- Hook - 4mm
- Safety eyes: I used different eyes for them, try and see which one looks nice for you. You can use felt eyes or crochet eyes if you like.
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker or a piece of yarn in a different color than those used in the pattern
- Needle
- Scissors

ABBREVIATIONS / US TERMS

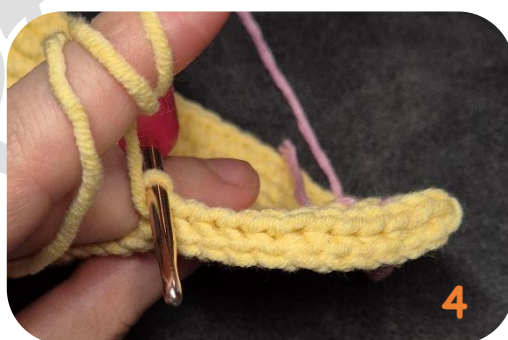
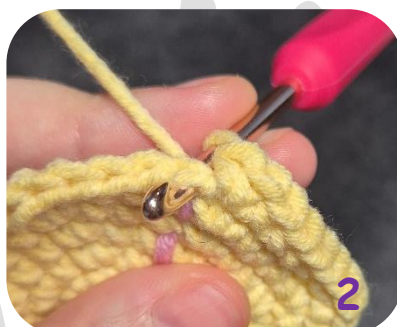
- CH - Chain
- SLST - Slip stitch
- SC - Single crochet
- DC - Double crochet
- HDC - Half double crochet
- INC - 2 Single crochet in one stitch
- DEC - Invisible decrease
- SC2tog - Crochet together 2 stitches (insert the hook through the next space and pull a loop, then insert the hook in the next space and pull another loop. Yarn over and pull a loop through all 3 loops from the hook).
- BPSC - Back post single crochet - explained below

Special stitch

1. BPSC - Back post single crochet.

I use this type of stitch to change crochet plans, so for this one, we initially made the base of the glasses holder - on a horizontal plane and now we need to make the walls in a vertical plan.

- Ch1 and turn the work, you will be working backwards now in order to crochet from the exterior.
- Insert the hook in a space from top to bottom (picture 2);
- Insert then the hook in the next space from bottom to the top (picture 3);
- Make a Single Crochet. Repeat the entire row. If you look back, you will notice that the row is made in a vertical plan, perpendicular on the base ☺



COLOR PALETTE

I used cotton yarn from YarnART Jeans Plus with yardage: 100grs. - 160m. / 3.52oz. - 174-98yds. You can use any other substitute with the same yardage characteristic or use a weight #2 yarn double stranded.

1. For bear:
 - a. Main color - color code 40: 21 gr.
 - b. Second color - color code 07: 3 gr.
2. For cat:
 - a. Main color - color code 46: 24 gr.
 - b. Second color - color code 05: 5 gr.
3. For bunny:
 - a. Main color - color code 01: 36 gr.
4. For giraffe:
 - a. Main color - color code 88: 29 gr.
 - b. Second color - color code 40: 3 gr.
 - c. Muzzle color - color code 07: 2 gr.
5. For puppy:
 - a. Main color - color code 07: 28 gr.
6. For heeler puppy:
 - a. Main color - color code 54: 24 gr.
 - b. Muzzle color - color code 88: 4 gr.
 - c. Decoration color - color code 15: 3 gr.

CROCHET PATTERN

1. Base

The base is the same for all variants.

Crochet with main color, Ch19 and crochet in 2nd chain from hook.

- **R1** → INC, SCx16, **4SC in the same chain**,
continue on the other side of the chain: SCx16 INC[40]
- **R2** → INCx2, SCx16, INCx4, SCx16, INCx2[48]
- **R3** → (SC, INC)x2, SCx16, (SC, INC)x4, SCx16, (SC, INC)x2[56]
- **R4** → (SCx2, INC)x2, SCx16, (SCx2, INC)x4, SCx16, (SCx2, INC)x2[64]
- **R5** → (SCx3, INC)x2, SCx16, (SCx3, INC)x4, SCx16, (SCx3, INC)x2[72]
- **R6** → (SCx4, INC)x2, SCx16, (SCx4, INC)x4, SCx16, (SCx4, INC)x2[80]

In order to crochet the wall perpendicular on the base, ch1 and turn so you will crochet from the outside of the base. The 7th row is made on the post of the Single crochets from row 6.

- **R7** → BPSCx80[80] SLST, ch1 and continue (do not turn)
- **R8-9** → SCx80[80] SLST, ch1 and continue (do not turn)
- **R10** → (SCx2, SC2tog)x2, SCx19, (SC2tog, SCx4)x4,
SCx16, SC2tog, SCx4, SC2tog, SCx3[72]

Fasten off, cut and hide the yarn.



2. Ears - make 2

Bear	Crochet with main color in a magic ring SCx5, pull the yarn end but do not pull it completely	☐ R1 → INCx5[5] ch1, turn ☐ R2 → (SC, INC)x5[10] ch1, turn ☐ R3 → skip 1 sts, SC2tog, SCx3, SC2tog, skip 1 sts and SLT to the end Fasten off, cut the yarn leaving a yarn end for sewing.
Bunny	Using main color yarn, crochet into a magic ring	☐ R1 → SCx6[6] ☐ R2 → (SC, INC)x3.....[9] ☐ R3 → (SC, INC, SC)x3.....[12] ☐ R4 → (SCx3, INC)x3.....[15] ☐ R5-15 → SCx15[15] Fold the ears and close them crocheting SCx7 across (through both sides). Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a long yarn end for sewing.
Giraffe	Using main color yarn, crochet into a magic ring	☐ R1 → SCx6[6] ☐ R2 → (SC, INC)x3.....[9] ☐ R3 → (SC, INC, SC)x3.....[12] ☐ R4-8 → SCx12[12] ☐ R9 → (SC, DEC, SC)x3.....[9] Fold the ears and close them crocheting SCx4 across (through both sides). Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a long yarn end for sewing.
Puppy	Ch2 and crochet in 2 nd chain from hook using turning rows.	☐ R1 → SCx2[2] ch1, turn ☐ R2 → INCx2[4] ch1, turn ☐ R3 → SCx4[4] ch1, turn ☐ R4 → INC, SCx2, INC[6] ch1, turn ☐ R5 → INC, SCx4, INC[8] ch1, turn ☐ R6 → SCx8[8] ch1, turn ☐ R7 → INC, SCx6, INC[10] ch1, turn ☐ R8 → SC2tog, SCx6, SC2tog ...[8] ch1, turn ☐ R9-11 → SCx8[8] Ch1 and crochet SCx10 on a side, 3 SC in the tip and another SCx10 on the other side. SLST to the base. Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a long yarn end for sewing.

Cat	Ears are made from 2 pieces: the inner side made in second color and outer side made in main color. Crochet the inner side firstly, then the outer side. Ch2 and crochet in 2 nd chain from hook.	☐ R1 → SCx2[2] turn ☐ R2 → INCx2[4] turn ☐ R3 → SCx4[4] turn ☐ R4 → INC, SCx2, INC[6] turn ☐ R5 → SCx6[6] For the inner side: Fasten off, cut the yarn short. For the outer side: Ch1, place the inner side on top of it and crochet them together on 2 sides: SCx5, 3 SC in the tip and Scx5 on the other side. Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a yarn end for sewing.
Heeler puppy		☐ R1 → SCx2[2] turn ☐ R2 → INCx2[4] turn ☐ R3 → SCx4[4] turn ☐ R4 → INC, SCx2, INC[6] turn ☐ R5-6 → SCx6[6] For the inner side: Fasten off, cut the yarn short. For the outer side: Ch1, place the inner side on top of it and crochet them together on 2 sides: SCx5, 3 SC in the tip and Scx5 on the other side. Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a yarn end for sewing.

3. Additional elements

Giraffe horns	Crochet with second color into a magic ring	☐ R1 → SCx6[6] ☐ R2 → INCx6.....[12] ☐ R3 → SCx12.....[12] ☐ R4 → DECx6.....[6] Add stuffing. Change to main color: ☐ R5-7 → SCx6[6] SLST Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a long yarn end for sewing.
Giraffe spots		☐ R1 → SCx6[6] Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a long yarn end for sewing.
Heeler puppy face long spot	Crochet with decoration color. Chain 7, crochet in the 2 nd chain from the hook.	☐ R1-3 → SCx6[6] ch1, turn ☐ R4 → INC, SCx4, INC.....[8] ch1, turn ☐ R5-14 → SCx6[6] Fasten off and cut the yarn leaving a long yarn end for sewing. For eyebrows: Ch4 and cut the yarn ends short.

4. Muzzle

Bear	Crochet with second color, Ch4 and crochet in 2 nd chain from hook	☐ R1 → INC, SC, 4SC in the same chain , continue on the other side of the chain: SC, INC[10] ☐ R2 → INCx2, SC, INC, HDCINCx2, INC, SC, INCx2 [14] ☐ R3 → SCx14[14] Fasten off, cut the yarn leaving a yarn end for sewing.
Bunny and cat	Crochet with second color, Ch5 and crochet in 2 nd chain from hook:	☐ R1 → INC, SCx2, 4SC in the same chain , continue on the other side of the chain: SCx2, INC ...[12] ☐ R2 → INCx2, SCx2, INCx4, SCx2, INCx2[20] ☐ R3 → (HDC, HDCINC)x2, SCx2, (HDC, HDCINC)x4, SCx2, (HDC, HDCINC)x2[28] ☐ R4 → (SC, SC2tog)x2, SLSTx2, (SC, SC2tog)x4, SLST, (SC, SC2tog)x2[20] Fasten off, cut the yarn leaving a yarn end for sewing.
Giraffe	Crochet with muzzle color, Ch5 and crochet in 2 nd chain from hook	☐ R1 → INC, SCx2, 4SC in the same chain , continue on the other side of the chain: SCx2, INC ...[12] ☐ R2 → INCx2, SCx2, INCx4, SCx2, INCx2[20] ☐ R3 → (HDC, HDCINC)x2, SCx2, (HDC, HDCINC)x2, SLSTx3 Fasten off, cut the yarn leaving a yarn end for sewing.
Puppy and Heeler puppy	Using the main color, crochet into a magic ring.	☐ R1 → SCx8[8] ☐ R2 → (3SC in one loop , SC)x4.....[16] ☐ R3-4 → SCx16[16] Fasten off, cut the yarn leaving a yarn end for sewing.
	Use the second color and crochet into a magic ring.	

5. Assembly

Sew the ears, horns and muzzles.
Add stuffing to the muzzle before fully sewn.

Sew or use hot silicone to attach the decoration elements.

Use a tiny bit of black yarn, glue at an end of the eye for the eyelids and then use a tiny drop to glue it to the base.

For heeler puppy eyes, use felt and the following specifications:

My final measurement for one eye is:
3.3cm (1.29inch) height and 2.8cm (1.10inch) width.

- Cut a rectangular shape from the white felt. Fold it in half and cut the eye shape
- Glue the white part of the eye over the black felt.
- Cut the black felt a bit wider around the white one, so it will be as a contour for the eyes.
- Cut the pupils for the eyes. Glue the pupils over the white part of the eyes
- Glue the eyes on the face.
